Also, please attach a list of everything the camper brings to the inside of one piece of luggage. You may use this equipment list. Just mark the quantities of each item inside the spaces given.

Luggage: Trunks are not used to store belongings at camp. Boxes, suitcases, or duffel bags work well for transporting camper belongings.

Laundry: Campers' laundry is washed at least once each session.

- ~ New campers will be assigned to a clan and given a clan shirt. Returning campers who have misplaced or outgrown their clan shirts may purchase replacements for \$10/shirt.

- ~ Clothing should be cut modestly (no exposed bellies, very low cut pants, or extremely short shorts, please.)
- ~ Loose, comfortable clothing is best for camp activities.
- ~ Please note that flip flop and sandal use in camp is limited, but useful at the waterfront & for trips to the bathroom.
